

Scenario: Creating Your First Personal Introduction Webpage.

A student named Aline is learning web development for the first time. Her teacher gives her an assignment to create a simple webpage using different basic HTML tags. The goal is for Aline to practice how HTML elements work together to structure a webpage.

Aline decides to create a small personal introduction page. She uses the following tags:

- `<html>` and `<body>` to define the main structure
- `<h1>` to create a main title for the page
- `<p>` to add paragraphs describing herself
- `<img>` to insert her profile picture
- `<ul>` and `<li>` to list her hobbies
- `<a>` to create a link to her school website
- `<br>` to break lines
- `<hr>` to separate sections with a horizontal line

After finishing, her webpage looks like a simple online profile. She opens it in a browser using `index.html` and confirms that the structure, text, image, and link all display correctly.

NB: Using the task that Aline committed to do, take your machine and create the interface that Aline intends to develop. After finishing, write the code structure you created in your website development notebook.
